**TOMORROW at 1 PM: State Unemployment Site Down Temporarily to Conduct
Maintenance; Users Must Be Logged Off by 1 PM**

CARSON CITY, NV - The Nevada Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation (DETR) has announced their unemployment insurance (UI) website (<http://ui.nv.gov>) will be down TOMORROW, Saturday, June 6, 2020 at 1 p.m. until 7 p.m., the period of lowest traffic, in order to conduct routine maintenance. During this time, all unemployment insurance functions, including unemployment insurance filing will not be functional. Filers are encouraged to visit the site after 7 p.m. on Saturday evening.
