DETR Changes Its Weekly Press Briefing Format; Sets Deadline for Question Submission

CARSON CITY, NV — In order to provide the press and public with ongoing and timely information, while also doing the important work of the organization, DETR announced today that it has changed the format of its weekly press briefings. While the event will still take place via digital technology, the briefings will no longer include a question and answer period following agency remarks.

DETR continues to encourage the press to submit their questions prior to the briefing. In response to the new format and to allow time for sufficient time for the agency to address questions, the agency asks that media submit their questions to detrmedia@detr.nv.gov by noon Thursday. For future briefings, media should submit questions by close of business on Wednesday preceding the briefing.

As a reminder, the agency does not address specific claimant scenarios, but regularly provides updates addressing trends being experienced by filers. We appreciate your patience and look forward to addressing your questions at our regularly-scheduled press briefing Friday.
