**TOMORROW at 5AM: DETR Sites Down Temporarily for Maintenance; No  
Impact to State Unemployment Insurance or PUA Sites**

CARSON CITY, NV - The Nevada Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation (DETR) has announced their agency websites, ([detr.nv.gov](http://detr.nv.gov) and [nevadajobconnect.com](http://nevadajobconnect.com)) will be down on Thursday, July 30, 2020 at 5 a.m. until 7 a.m., a period of lowest traffic, in order to conduct system maintenance. During this time, the agency sites will not be functional, and filers will not be able to access the resource materials on the COVID webpage. Filers are encouraged to visit the aforementioned sites after 7 a.m. on Thursday morning. This maintenance will not impact the state unemployment insurance website ([ui.nv.gov](http://ui.nv.gov)) and claimants attempting to file online will not be affected.
