**TODAY at 1PM: Unemployment Insurance Site Down Temporarily for
Maintenance; No Impact to PUA Site**

CARSON CITY, NV - The Nevada Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation (DETR) has announced their unemployment insurance site (ui.nv.gov) will be down today, Saturday, August 15, 2020 at 1 p.m. until 7 p.m., a time of lower traffic, in order to conduct regular system maintenance. During this time, the site will not be functional, and filers will not be able to file claims or access the resource materials on the website. Filers are encouraged to visit the site after 7 p.m. tonight. This maintenance will not impact the PUA site (employnv.gov) and individuals filing PUA claims online will not be affected.
