**Unemployment Insurance and Pandemic Unemployment Assistance  
Call Centers Closed for Holiday; public can still file online**

CARSON CITY, NV - The Nevada Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation (DETR) has announced that the unemployment insurance and Pandemic Unemployment Assistance call centers will be closed for the Labor Day holiday, Monday, September 7, 2020.

Individuals will not be able to contact call center staff to file claims or ask any questions. The call centers will reopen on Tuesday, September 8th at 8 a.m.
